## Resolution urging Whatcom County voters to vote NO on six Republican-sponsored statewide initiatives

**WHEREAS** Washington State Republican Party Chair <u>Jim Walsh is sponsoring six initiatives</u> to the 2024 Washington State Legislature that primarily seek to repeal vital laws adopted by the Washington State Legislature over the past three years;

**WHEREAS** a <u>single individual almost exclusively funds the campaign for these six initiatives</u>. Right-wing multi-millionaire Brian Heywood, who by his own admission wants Washington to be a tax haven for the wealthy and has donated over 87% of the funding for signature gathering and other operations in support of the six initiatives as of December 2023;

**WHEREAS** the first of these initiatives, <u>I-2117</u>, would eliminate billions of dollars in Climate Commitment Act revenue, jeopardizing good-paying, local jobs in our communities, such as making homes energy-efficient or installing heat pumps and solar panels;

**WHEREAS** the second of these initiatives, <u>I-2081</u>, would undermine the ability of youth to access gender-affirming and reproductive care services through their schools;

**WHEREAS** the third of these initiatives, <u>I-2113</u>, would undermine public safety by allowing the resumption of dangerous high-speed police chases for petty offenses like expired tabs, putting the lives of police officers, drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians at risk;

**WHEREAS** the fourth of these initiatives, <u>I-2109</u>, would give millionaires and billionaires a tax break by repealing the capital gains tax on the wealthy (applying only to those with annual capital gains above (\$250,000) and eliminate \$900+ million every year for early learning, K-12 education, and school construction;

**WHEREAS** the fifth of these initiatives, <u>I-2111</u>, would prohibit the state or any of its localities from levying taxes on income, using a very broad definition of income that could jeopardize existing progressive revenue sources which aren't actually taxes on Washingtonians' income;

**WHEREAS** the sixth of these initiatives, <u>I-2124</u>, would sabotage the Washington Cares long-term care system, leaving every Washingtonian at the mercy of expensive big long-term care insurance companies that only the wealthiest and most affluent can afford;

WHEREAS many were not fully informed about what they were signing, instead being advised to sign to "lower the cost of living."

**WHEREAS** Walsh, Heywood, and their supporters claim to have collected sufficient signatures to qualify these six initiatives, all of which have already been certified;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** on the November 2024 general election ballot Whatcom Democrats:

urges a NO vote on Initiative 2117, which would repeal the Climate Commitment Act.

- urges a NO vote on Initiative 2081, which targets any inclusive curriculum that contains discussions of race, discrimination, and LGBTQ identities.
- urges a NO vote on Initiative 2113, which would repeal reasonable restrictions on police pursuits that are making our communities safer.
- urges a NO vote on Initiative 2109, which would repeal billions in education funding by eliminating the capital gains tax on the wealthy.
- urges a NO vote on Initiative 2111, which would bar the state and local governments from levying taxes based on ability to pay.
- urges a NO vote on Initiative 2124, which would sabotage the WA Cares plan enacted to help Washingtonians afford long-term care.

Adopted by a vote of 68 to 1 at the 24 February 2024 General Membership Meeting of Whatcom County Democrats.
